

Donated Goods Discount Depot Guidelines

VolunteerNow operates two Donated Goods Discount Depot stores - one in Dallas and one in Fort Worth - to help nonprofits stretch limited budgets. Offering primarily new and some gently used items, including clothing, office supplies, furniture, equipment, and health and beauty items donated by local and national retailers and manufacturers, we help nonprofits save up to 80 percent on critical items that support their mission and delivery of services.

Who can shop:

Both Donated Goods Discount Depots are open to member nonprofits, all active and retired military, school district employees, police officers, firefighters, and EMTs. Shoppers must be at least 12 years old.

Hours and locations:

Donated Goods is open 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday-Friday and 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. on Saturdays.

Logistics:

- DG Discount Depot is not open to the public.
- Each shopper may bring one guest when they shop. **All guests must be over 12 years of age.**
- All agency shoppers and guests will be required to sign-in with their name, agency and email address.
Monthly prize drawings will be held for all those on the sign-in sheets.
- Items purchased in DG may not be resold.
- Each purchase will include a \$2 fee to cover administrative costs previously offset by membership fees.
